

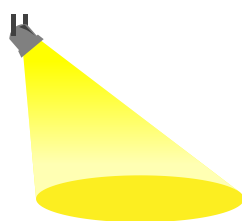
Join us for our Cocoa on the Go event to learn more about Maggie's Place!

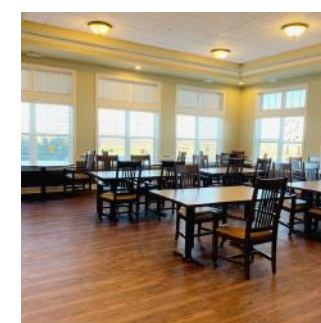
